

Lynch Brothers Cleaning Instructions

- 1. DO NOT** use abrasive or harsh chemicals such as ammonia, dishwashing detergent, powdered all-purpose cleaner, Endust, Pledge, **Murphy's Oil Soap** or any type of wax or silicone based products on your floor.
- 2. No waxing** Once you wax a floor, it should be maintained as a wax-finished floor. Wax may inhibit the adhesion of future application of top coating materials or make it slippery.
- 3. Don't soak** Never mop a hardwood floor with a soaking wet mop. Water can dull the finish and/or damage the wood.
- 4. Water and Vinegar (1 gal to 1 cup)** While many still feel this is an option for cleaning, some finish companies are saying that the acidity breaks down the finish causing the sheen of the finish to dull over time.

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- Sweep or vacuum your hardwood floor on a regular basis (about once a week) just as you would any floor covering. Make sure no rocks or pebbles get lodged in the bristles, they will cause damage to your finish.
